CHANGES FROM SEASON II

❑ **EXPANSION TO 32 CLUBS**

There will be 8 conferences of 4 clubs in each for a total of 32 clubs in Season III.

❑ **YOUNGER AGE DIVISIONS**

2011 will be the oldest age group supported by CCS, all others become Showcase.

❑ **SINGLE AGE DIVISIONS**

4 Single Age Boys (2011, 2012, 2013, 2014) 2 Dual Age Girls (2011/2012, 2013/2014) and 1 Co-Ed (2015/2016) will comprise the 7 teams commitment.

❑ **TWO DAYS CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT**

Conference tournament will take place on Saturday and Sunday only.

❑ **2 TOURNAMENTS REQUIRED, NOT 3**

Nationals becomes optional. Juvenil and Cadete Boys will have a Showcase Nationals.

❑ **3 WORLD FUTSAL CHAMPIONSHIPS EACH SUMMER**

World Futsal Championships will be held in 3 locations to make it more flexible for clubs.

❑ **DUAL NATIONAL TRAINING CAMPS**

To help with conflicts, there will be an East and West NTC in June moving forward.

FOR TEAMS:

2 TOURNAMENTS PER YEAR

Conference Championships (Winter) and World Futsal Championships (Summer)

4 Official Matches Guaranteed at each tournament. 3 convenient options to play World Futsal Championships each Summer.

QUALIFY FOR NATIONALS

Exclusive opportunity to qualify for the United Futsal National Championships

The Top 2 finishers in each conference make up the 16 Division I National Championships contenders, the rest are invited to compete for the D2 crown.

WORLD FUTSAL CUP

Exclusive opportunity to win a FREE entry in the World Futsal Cup

Division I National Champions receive a FREE bid while Runners-Up receive the 2nd American Invitation to compete against the world's best.

HOW DOES IT WORK? FOR TEAMS

- We invite 32 clubs to participate each year. These clubs must deliver 7 teams according to our age division chart, which begins each year at U9 and finishes at U14.
- The teams are then broken into 8 Conferences of 4 clubs in each. Each of the 7 teams will compete against each other in a round-robin group stage followed by a final and 3rd place game for a total of 4 matches for every team.
- Based on how they finish in Conferences in the Winter, each team will be seeded for World Futsal Championships in the Summer. There are 3 options to attend: Orlando in partnership with Universal Resort, in Connecticut with Mohegan Sun Resort and in Las Vegas with Mandalay Bay Resort. Each team will also receive 4 matches guaranteed, but there will be International teams and/or open domestic teams invited to make the brackets more exciting.

HOW DOES IT WORK? FOR TEAMS

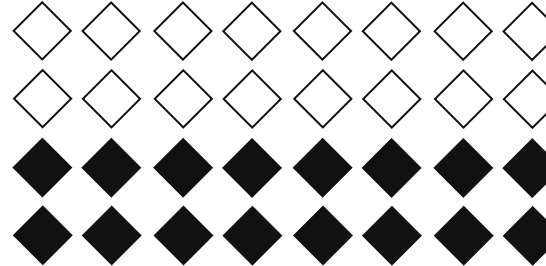
- Any team finishing Conference Championships in 1st or 2nd place qualifies for Division I National Championships which take place 2 days before the World Championships in Orlando each year. Anyone finishing 3rd or 4th place has the option to come to Orlando and compete in the Division II National Championships but is not required to do so.
- The winner and 2nd place finisher of Division I National Championships are selected to represent the US in the World Futsal Cup against the best futsal clubs in the world like FC Barcelona, SC Corinthians, Benfica and more. The National Champion also receives tournament entry, housing, travel and more for FREE. They only need to pay the flights.

NATIONAL TRAINING CAMP

Exclusive opportunity to be chosen to compete at the National Training Camp

Only registered CCS players are eligible to be selected

UNITED FUTSAL FUTURES

Exclusive opportunity to be selected for the FUTURES program

National Training Camp invitees and waitlist participants are exclusively allowed to compete in United Futsal's most prestigious international program.

UNITED FUTSAL PRO X

Priority acceptance into United Futsal's newest program: PRO X

All CCS Players will receive priority opportunity to be selected for the United Futsal PRO Experience featuring a different pro futsal club each Season.

HOW DOES IT WORK? FOR PLAYERS

Based on their performance in Conference Championships and recommendations from their club coaches and directors, 42 players and 8 goalkeepers are invited to participate in each of 2 National Training Camps in each Age Division. One which will take place to service player in the East and one to service players in the West. Players are able to request a transfer to the other NTC if date or location is preferred, as long as an open spot is available. Players cannot participate in both.

National Training Camp is a 5-day elite futsal training camp led by international coaches and players alongside the top futsal coaches in the US. In total there will be 2,240 players in the Champions Cup Series for Season III, 700 in total will participate in either of the National Training Camps. Only 31% of CCS Players will be chosen and no one from outside the CCS will be allowed to participate.

From the performance at National Training Camp along with evaluation from United Futsal professional coaching staff and directors, 24 players and 4 goalkeepers will be selected at each age division to participate in the United Futsal FUTURES program in Barcelona.

HOW DOES IT WORK? FOR PLAYERS

FUTURES is the most prestigious futsal training program in the world. Players from the US train and compete against players from other countries (like Australia, Brasil and England) under the direction of world class futsal coaches and former professional players for 9 days in Barcelona, Spain.

A total of 168 players and 28 goalkeepers will be selected to represent the US at the FUTURES program. Which represents only 9% of the Champions Cup Series players. No players outside the CCS are eligible to get to the FUTURES program. All other CCS players who are interested in an international futsal immersion are eligible to apply for our United Futsal Pro Experience (PRO X), a 9 day experience of living like a futsal pro with a different host club each year. For Season III, the program will take place in Valencia, Spain with host Levante Futsal of the Spanish 1st Division.

Only 168 players and 28 goalkeepers will be allowed to participate, representing another 9% of CCS membership. All NTC players who are not selected, or decline invitation to FUTURES are given priority acceptance to the PRO X. All other CCS members who apply but were not invited to the NTC, are given preference over any outside applicants for the PRO X. (These outside applicants refer to players from CCS Clubs who do not make official CCS rosters. It is our intention that no player outside the CCS is invited to the PRO X)

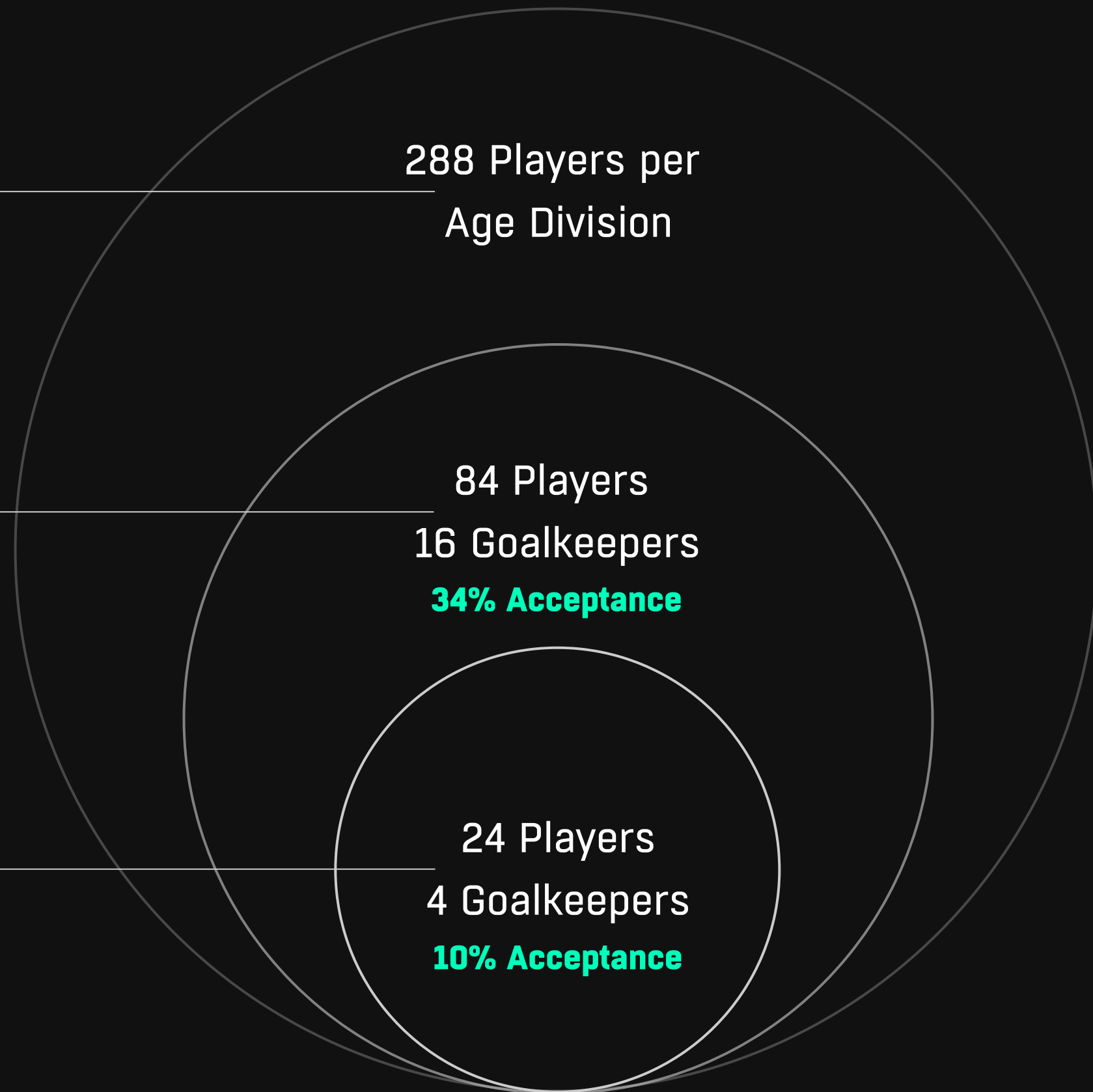
Each Year in a single age group there will be an average of 9 players per team for 32 teams eligible to compete in any aspect of the Player Development Program.

National Training Camp

42 Players plus 8 Goalkeepers are selected to attend each of 2 National Training Camps each year. One held in the East and one in the West.

FUTURES and PRO X

A Total of 24 Players and 4 Goalkeepers are invited to participate in FUTURES from the NTC. An additional 24 Players and 4 Goalkeepers are offered spaces at Pro X from NTC and other CCS Applicants.

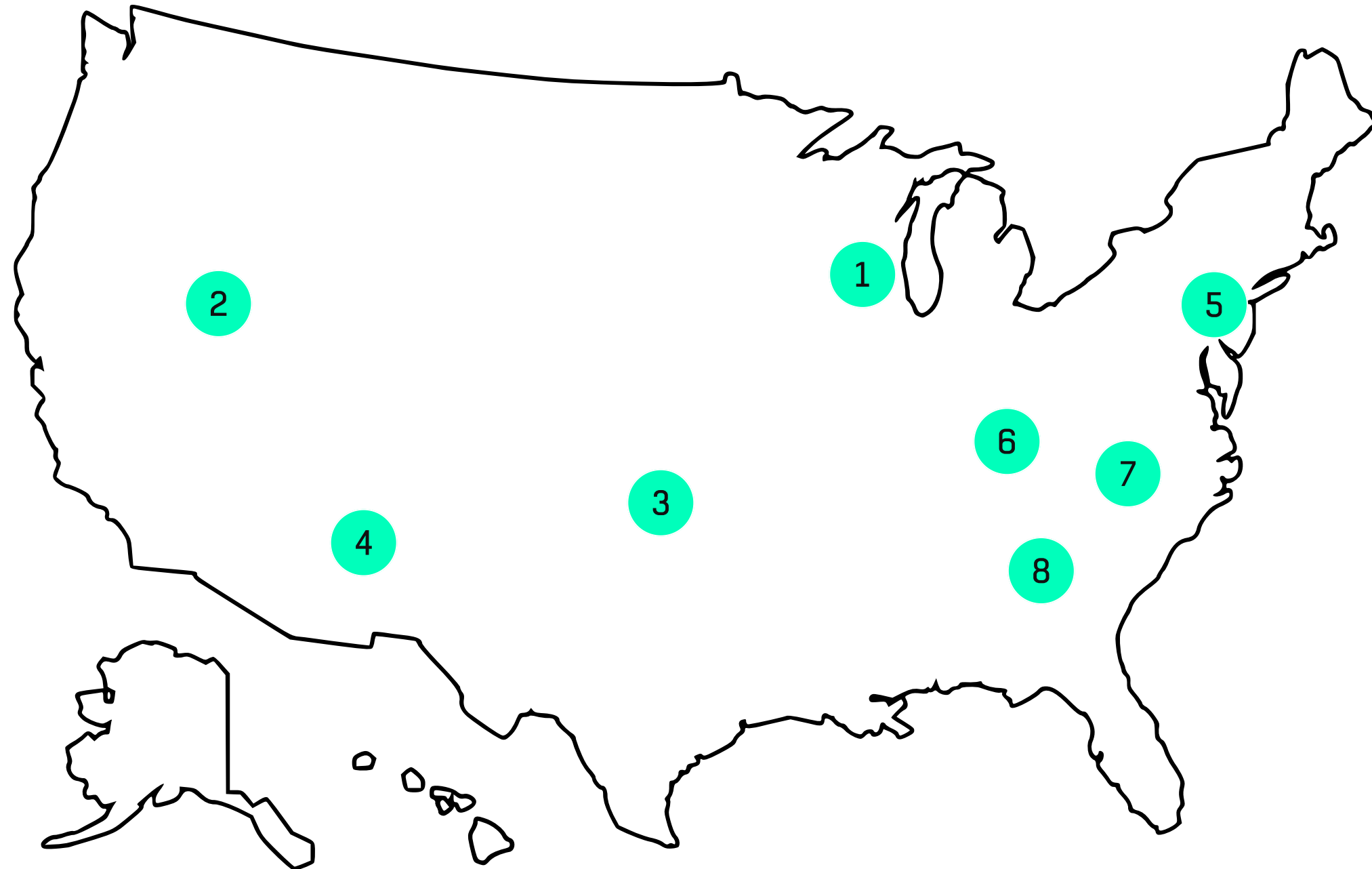
